Lines 181 to 184 – The formula for Food Security Index was written in two different ways. Which one did you use? Be specific and use one or make a good clarification if you mean both were applicable. Line 210 – (Table)...which Table? Line 215 – Table not properly labelled. No number. Line 218 – (Table). Which Table? Line 221 – Surname of the first author and <i>et al.</i> only are required. Line 228 – Table not numbered and no proper label. Line 263 – R^2 not R2. Line 280 – Do not mention any figure in conclusion.
