In table 2, the superscript “a” on the data is not defined.</li> <li>8. In the abstract, the increases in the the bio-yield force and bio-yield energy as well as in the rupture parameters could be converted to percentages. It shouldn't look exactly the same as it is in the conclusion.</li> <li>9. Line 210: The word “gotten” should be changed to “obtained”</li> </ol>	All corrections have been made, apart from the “a” and “b” which are statistical notations given by the SPSS packages to show the separations are means, which I defined at the bottom of the table.
