<p>The English language in this revised version is still poor. Suggestions in this direction made by the reviewer attest to this. The authors must pay attention to this aspect. When several numerical references are quoted, they should appear in increasing order. This should be corrected every where in the text where indicated.</p> <p><b>Introduction</b> Heavy metals, volatile organic matters, and polyaromatic hydrocarbons are not greenhouse gases. This confusion is due solely to bad punctuation.</p> <p><b>Materials and Methods</b> the sentence "The material and methods used for this research are discussed below." is unnecessary. The last paragraph in paragraph 2.2 gives result and should be placed appropriately as suggested. Terms in an equation must be defined after the equation in a running sentence and not like other equations, for the reader to be familiar with such values.</p> <p><b>Results and Discussion</b> The spacing in Tables 3.1 and 3.2 should be uniform with the others. The column titles in Tables 3.1 and 3.2 should carry the units, not the key.</p>
