

It can be in physical term (kg, litres) or in monetary terms(naira) What you did is not acceptable at all. The inputs should be feed, medications, labour etc	
	Line 273-275 – using tobit regression at least one of the dependent variable must be zero(0). If you have zero managerial efficiency score, then it is ok and you should run tobit using censored from below(or lower limit in stata) but if not run using censored from above (or upper limit). Use their real scores and don't adjudge Managerial efficiency scores that were below 0.5 as inefficient and thus given the value zero. You need to re- run this too.
