Author(s) suggested that AE treatment could increase shelf life and maintain quality of tomato fruits during storage. In 2.4 Extract concentrations, AEs are prepared by dissolving 80 or 100g of leaf powder in 100 ml of sterile distilled water. However, it does not dissolved completely in water as these concentrations are highest. Author(s) need to investigate using low concentrations of AEs again.
