Please fix the inconsistency for proper citation formatting.</p> <p><b>Once the recommendation is implemented, please publish the article.</b></p>	<p>I actually complained about the length of the quotation but my colleague who wrote that section of the work insisted on leaving it like that. We will look into it and do the needful.</p> <p>We will take another look at the conclusion and citations. One more thing, some of the citations do not have page numbers because we did not directly quote them. Only the direct quotes have pagination attached. Also, those authors without date have written in front of them 'cited in...' or 'in...' We were only citing the author(s) of the work(s) we studied.</p> <p>Thank you for your comments.
