It is used several times.</li> <li>Line-43: earth's – e should be capital (Earth's)</li> <li>Line-80: SDG 6- What is this?</li> <li>Line 138-139: "Frequency occurrences for different durations at which people accessed water and returned to their homes were not the same (x2 = 83.52, df =3)" – why the author is comparing the accessing time and return to home time? How they are relevant? What are the factors influencing the duration to rerun home after accessing water?</li> <li>Line 202: summary of may be used instead of summary for since for is used two times.</li> </ol>
