Foreign bodies can be detected with plain radiography, CT scans, MRI and ultrasonography. Among all the imaging techniques CT is the gold standard for visualization of foreign bodies. Access to the foreign bodies depends on its location and surgical access can be gained through intra-oral or extraoral approach. If there is an existing scar access can also be gained through it. Thorough debridement of the wound with proper irrigation should be carried out followed by closure. Routine postoperative screening and radiography should be done.
