<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<p>This is a case report of a typical case of gallstone ileus. The manuscript is poorly and superficially written. The English is suboptimal, superficial and lacks scientific robustness. The vast majority of references are very old despite the presence of more than 1000 articles on the subject. The short abstract indicates that a review article should be expected. However, most importantly, even in its best corrected form, this article would have nothing to add to the current literature as it describes a common case of gallstone ileus with the addition of a poor discussion that repeats a limited proportion of well-established knowledge on the subject.</p> <p>Unknown whether appropriate consent has been obtained.</p>	<p>Sir consent from the patient is taken and ethical committee clearance is done. I refuse to accept that gallstone ileus is very common. Cholecystectomy has become so rampant in india..in last 20 yrs in my institution there was no case of gallstone ileus.so please accept that this case report</p>
