Compulsory REVISION comments	The submitted manuscript has been focused in the study of the protective effects of the ginseng, green tea, cinnamon and their combination against the hepatotoxicity of acetamiprid in rats. Although the authors have completed a reasonable study with very informative data on the investigation of various physiological functions, the most concerns are the limited information of the used samples in the animal studies, especially the dosages of each plant. In addition, the composition of plant materials used in the study should be presented to indicate the potent functions of the compounds existed in the plants. It was strongly suggested that the authors should update these data before the further consideration in the publication.	
Minor REVISION comments	The bar graph would be better for the presentation of the experiment data, i.e. Table 3, 4 and 5. P. 2, The chemical composition of green tea... The references should be updated.
