The manuscript entitled "SWOT Analysis of Large Cardamom in Ilam District, Nepal" has revealed factors that contribute to strengthening Large Cardamom development in Ilam district of Nepal including, in the decreasing order of importance, the relatively high profit, and high demand in international market, to name a few. The opportunities have also been identified notably the establishment of an essential oil extraction industry and the development variety according to altitude. The two most important weakness factors were the high price fluctuation and the lack of farmers' knowledge on orchard management. Declining productivity due to diseases and high fluctuation in selling price constituted the two first threats to LC business in Ilam district.

Majority of reviewers' comments were considered by the author (s) that contributed to improving the quality of the manuscript.

Nevertheless, The Asian Journal of Research in Agriculture and Forestry (AJRAF) cannot yet be advised to publish the manuscript provided that comments made in the revised manuscript pertaining to the scientific writing and to the English language attached herewith this e-mail are fully considered.
