Author(s) should effect all corrections as pointed out in the manuscript.</li> <li>3. The experiment was a 3 x 3 factorial. This was not mentioned.</li> <li>4. The experimental design was randomized complete block design since the crop was planted in the soil/field directly</li> <li>5. The use two replication only was not ideal for analysis of variance statistical tool</li> <li>6. Adopt the journal's style and format of referencing in completing the references in this manuscript</li> <li>7. The names of all journals cited in the manuscript should be written in full and not abbreviated to ease cross referencing and citation counts</li> </ol>
