Introduction should have little explanation on ulam, like vegetables used and mention objectives of this review.</li> <li>3. There is no mention of material &amp; methods, please refer (Bachok et al., 2014, Asia Pac J Clin Nutr 2014;23(3):369-376)</li> <li>4. Author has to gather all the ingredients vegetables used for preparing ulam and come up with a table.</li> <li>5. Tables are to be made to put information at one place regarding studies carried to till date and their outcomes.</li> <li>6. Discussion is missing!!</li> </ol>	Noted
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use of terms like; "This study", "This finding" "present study"...try to avoid such terms...use past tense instead</li> </ol>	Noted
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The review manuscript entitled "Effectiveness of traditional medicinal vegetables (ulam) against pathogenic microorganisms" is a good attempt in concentrating scattered knowledge, and also it is written well. However, there are several shortcomings in the manuscript and are to be addressed. Review should have four parts like, <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Title and abstract, 2.
