Minor REVISION comments	Authors describe a rare but dangerous complication of PCNL. The abdominal compartment syndrome is characterized by an abdominal pressure > 20 mmHg that leads, among other things, to decreased venous return and ventilatory problems. It is very important to recognize this life-threatening complication in order to limit his negative effects. This is not the first report of such a complication but literature on this topic is very scant and new reports on this topics could be of interest to the urological community. The case presentation is well done and also the discussion and conclusions section is complete. In the references section the most important works on this topic are reported. Considering that the lack of novelty is not an issue for the Asian Journal of Research and Reports in Urology, I think that it could be published with the only suggestion to add the dimensions of the stone at the end of the line 31 .
