<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<p>Line 45</p> <p>The authors present 'A study on awareness for climate variability and effects on water resources among farm women'. They interviewed 120 farm women from three districts of Punjab. Their investigations showed that majority of the farm women are fully aware of some of the reasons responsible for climate change like pollution, deforestation, paddy rise burning and cultivation of paddy. Most of the women believed that variations in temperature and rainfall are caused by climate change while majority are fully aware that climate change is putting pressure on water which is also wasted while performing domestic duties. However, since majority of the farm women have medium level of awareness about the reasons responsible for climate change and low level of awareness on causes of depletion of water table, hence called for improved awareness on climate change and better technology for managing water.</p> <p>This is an important study which can provide useful information that can help to improve water management and raise the awareness about climate change.</p>
