<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Legends of figures for Figure 3 and Figure 4 are similar.</li> <li>Gel electrophoresis picture is not in the acceptable format (difficult to understand).</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Legend of figure 4 was corrected.</li> <li>Gel electrophoresis picture is removed from the manuscript.</li> </ol>
<b><u>Minor</u></b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sentence should not begin with numerals. Many paragraphs of materials and methods are started with numerals.</li> <li>If abbreviations are defined in abstract then there is no need to write the full name in methodology.</li> <li>Most of the sentences in result are in present tense. This indicates grammatical errors.</li> <li>Need to write conclusion specific.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All sentences beginning with numerals were corrected.</li> <li>Full name repeats were removed from introduction and methodology.</li> <li>Sentences in present tense were corrected (three sentences!).</li> <li>Discussion and Conclusion were revised to be more specific.</li> </ol>
<b><u>Optional/General</u></b> comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use <b>min</b> for minutes <b>h</b> for hours <b>s</b> for seconds <b>d</b> for days</li> </ol>	Min and h were used, representing minutes and hours, respectively.
