There are many English grammar and syntax errors along the manuscript that must be		
corrected. For example, line 24 in the introduction, the author starts the sentence in		
thepresent tense and the in the next line past tense is used. Again, hepatitis virus		
serological markers are not unified, e.g. HBsAg or HBs Ag are written in the text. Also,		
anti-HBcore and anti-HB core are observed. Health care workers acronyms was used		
once (HCWs) but sometimes it is written without the acronyms. There are more words		
and sentences that need revision.		
Discussion should be addressed deeper. What was found previously? What is the		
importance of the authors' findings? There are policies that should be implemented		
with these findings? Are there limitations in the present study?
