The methods and results section are appropriate. However, the Introduction part is very large and the discussion part is very short. Many of the part described in the Introduction part must be kept in Discussion section eg. "The Approach" section. 2. Some typological errors are also there eg page 6, line no. 85. 3. The dose of Voglibose as stated by authors are 0.2-0.3 mg. This is a dose for adult generally weighs 65-70 kg. Means the dose is 0.2-0.3 mg/65-70 kg. What is the reason behind taking 0.3, 0.4, 0.5 mg/ml voglibose solution for analysis. 4. The methods described are novel, but some References must be quoted in "Methodology" section, as to provide the basis that from where the authors get the idea for following that procedure only. Is it hit and trial.?, if yes, than another trials must be described with results.
