It is good that the percentage of correct answers has been increased to 80% for regard a person having good knowledge. However all analyses need to be recalculated with this new definition, which has not been done. It is still written in Abstract that 84 % have good knowledge and Table 3 has not been changed. In Figure 1 the number of persons the % is calculated on needs to be presented. I opposite to what is written at row 8 in Abstract the number of deaths due to HIV has decreased at least in parts of Sub-saharian Africa due to more patients on treatment and is now more a chronic disease.
