Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The statement in Abstract, background that deaths due to HIV is increasing in Sub-Saharan Africa is not true. It is decreasing due to more at treatment.</p> <p>Methods: I don't think it could be regarded as a good knowledge about HIV if answering only 50 % of the questions correct. I recommend a higher level for good knowledge on around 80%.</p> <p>Results in Abstract: Specify more clear which groups that have better knowledge: married, secondary level of education and employed and that no significant effect of age was noted.</p> <p>You can discuss more the routes of transmission with low knowledge among the women.</p> <p>Did only 8 persons answer the question in table 6 compared to all 400 the question in table 5 ?</p> <p>The number of references (11) are quite few and more could be added and discussed.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	There are several spelling mistakes which can be corrected by the automatic function in MS Word.	
Optional/General comments	Mostly confirming results seen in other studies.	

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
