Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>1)The importance of screening adolescents for hypertension and target organ damage need to a be highlighted by quoting facts and figures from literature .</p> <p>2) A few months study period is too small to draw inferences about target organ damage . An emphasis on absent adolescent target organ damage would be counter productive to the interests of the article as it is likely to send wrong signals of drawing hasty conclusions.</p> <p>3) The situation can be retrieved by instead of emphasising the fact of no target organ damage in the affected group, emphasizing that this group need to be given close follow-up for early detection of target organ damage.</p>	Reviewer comment is accepted and had been corrected and highlighted in yellow .
