

Editor's Comment:

The manuscript still lacks a proper statistical analysis of data; and therefore, table 2 and figures 7-12 must be amended. Authors clearly have to indicate which data is statistically different when compared to each other; it is not enough to indicate that a $P < 0.05$ or a $p < 0.001$ was set for significance. The standard way to do so is to include symbols on the top of the bar(s) is (are) different. The same strategy can be used in table 2. See examples in the literature, it is the standard way to report significance.
