Specify, was she not taking any other medication? 4. Elaborate the lesion for readers. (eg. On examination, dusky red colour nummular patch of 8 cm diameter was seen over left clavicular area and a similar smaller nummule measuring 5 cm diameter over right lateral aspect of lower trunk). 5. Make discussion coherent and of an appropriate length. 6. Referencing not up-to-date and appropriate. 7. A clear overall message is not conveyed by the paper. 	<p>Thank you for your advices.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We edited the introduction section and remarked. 2. We established the scales according to your advice and added in the case report section and remarked. 3. She wasn't taking any other medication. 4.
