<b><u>Optional/General</u></b> comments	The manuscript is of very low quality and is full of technical inaccuracies. The first statement reads "Blastomycosis dermatitidis..." where the actual species name/genus is "Blastomyces dermatitidis". The authors fail to recognize that blastomycosis is caused by two species of Blastomyces. Blastomycosis infection occurs world wide; however, is more common in certain regions. The references do not support many claims made by the authors. The authors mention that the case occurred out of the area of endemicity but do not mention where the case occurred.
