The application of micronutrients at seed treatment with rhizobacteria as well as foliar sprays at definitive stages is no doubt helpful for the better productivity but practically cumbersome for the farmers. Of course, the study helps us know the impact of micronutrients on the physiological activities and their influence on the yield contributing characters. The experiment could also be used in optimizing the micronutrient concentrations required for the pigeonpea for better establishment as well as good yields.
