May times in the paper it refers to patient and her partners. Not all patients had more than one partner; therefore it should be patient and her partner(s). This is grammatically correct.</li> <li>3. Line 33: should read because of an infection. Delete "of the vaginal and/or cervical infection".</li> <li>4. Line 35 - the word vaginitis should be replaced with vaginal issue as bacterial vaginosis is not an "Itis" but a syndrome.</li> <li>5. Line 40 - Not all untreated vaginitis can results in pelvic inflammatory disease - e.g. candidiasis does not. Needs correcting.</li> </ol>
