4. Line 35 - the word vaginitis should be replaced	
with vaginal issue as bacterial vaginosis is not an	
"Itis" but a syndrome.	
5. Line 40 - Not all untreated vaginitis can results	
in pelvic inflammatory disease - e.g. candidiasis	
does not. Needs correcting.
