In Table 3 suppress the expression "(61)" and "100" that is repeated inside the cells. They could be rather placed at the end of each category of variables	
Minor REVISION comments	In the Abstract, how "the urgent need" to plant ogbono is justified? You do not give convincing arguments. In several places you say "militating", I guess it should be "limitating" Not all references were written according to journal's guidelines. Please check.	
Optional/General comments	For the most, paper is fine. Most comments are related to form issues, not to technical or methodological problems. However, it is recommended to check thoroughly grammar and spelling.
