I am not quite sure if bowls and containers qualify for depreciation. If so, how long is its estimated life? Also, you include an item "rent", what is this for? In Table 3 suppress the expression "(61)" and "100" that is repeated inside the cells. They could be rather placed at the end of each category of variables	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	In the Abstract, how "the urgent need" to plant ogbono is justified? You do not give convincing arguments. In several places you say "militating", I guess it should be "limitating" Not all references were written according to journal's guidelines. Please check.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	For the most, paper is fine. Most comments are related to form issues, not to technical or methodological problems. However, it is recommended to check thoroughly grammar and spelling.
