FINAL EVALUATOR'S comments on revised paper (if any)	Authors' response to final evaluator's comments
<p>The revised paper is good and it can be published. The only thing I suggest (very minor revision) is to eliminate the second decimals from the results section in the abstract (sentence indicated below): for example, it's better in my opinion to write "67.6" seconds instead of 67.59 seconds, or "194 platelets" instead of 193.62 platelets . Although mathematically correct, a clinician does not need the precision a tenth of a second or fractions of platelets in the results.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> The mean <math>\pm</math> SD values of the parameters assessed in the leukaemia patients include 3.74<math>\pm</math>3.13<math>\mu</math>g FEU/mL, 67.59<math>\pm</math>55.71seconds, 1.84<math>\pm</math>0.09, 77.34<math>\pm</math>31.81seconds, 193.62<math>\pm</math>102.79cells/mm<sup>3</sup>, 74<math>\pm</math>124.42 cells/mm<sup>3</sup>, 30.07 <math>\pm</math>5.38% for D-dimer, PT, INR, aPTT, platelets, WBC and PCV respectively.</p>	<p>Noted.</p> <p>It has been corrected as suggested.</p>
