<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	<p>A lot of ambiguous statements. Some suggestions for rephrasing were given.</p> <p>More details are needed in the literature, especially in the mechanisms of action of the nutraceuticals for specific ailments like cardiovascular disease.</p> <p>Distinction should be made between nutritional supplements and dietary supplements.</p> <p>The classification of some of the nutraceuticals is not clear cut, like herbs, phytochemicals, etc.</p> <p>The literature requires more content. There are lots of information available. It seems, however, that the number of references surpasses the information in the text.</p> <p>The diagram in fig 1 is unexplained. It does not appear to have much relevance to the work.</p>

<u>Optional/General</u> comments	<p>One major recurrent mistake is the choice of wrong words and poor construction of sentences which make them ambiguous, thus not conveying the true message.</p> <p>Please pay attention to the comments/notes in the highlighted portions.</p>
