<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. It should be also mentioned that the hydronephrosis may be due to operative procedure either during the initial c/section or subsequent surgeries.</li> <li>2. Discuss role of caesarean hysterectomy and Bilateral uterine artery/Hypogastric ligation.</li> <li>3. Discuss role of aspirin in increasing bleeding time.</li> <li>4. Need more lab data such as PT, INR Fibrinogen, platelets etc</li> <li>5. Also mention that if prenatal diagnoses is suspected then a high longitudinal c/section versus LTCS would be preferred.</li> <li>6. If the desired outcome is a healthy child then by the time a more definitive diagnosis is made abortion is not a choice as it carries similar risks and does not correct the problem. This should be omitted.</li> <li>7. Although continued professional psychological support is indeed very important, cannot advise for further testing with EEG and cognitive tests at this point.</li> </ol> <p><b>Ethical issues:</b> <b>Need a statement of medical review board regarding approval of this case for reporting</b></p>
