Flowing from these observations, it is expedient that authors should include precautionary measures to be adopted by different countries to forestall impending disturbances in the economic systems rather than contend with emergence of doomsday.	Sending to cryptocurrencies doesn't make sense as the volume of transactions is so far rather small in comparison with application of fiducial currency. However the reviewer is right that he draws the attention of authors to problems of development of transactions with cryptocurrencies. We will surely consider it in the next researches.
