<p>I do agree with the author that increased fossil fuels burning and detonation of explosives is what elevated the global warming of WWII era; and that, the growing of global industrialization, as well as the increasing global consumption of fossil fuels and explosives are the main causes of the increasing of global warming since the end of WWII.</p> <p>But, not with the author's arguments that it is mainly through the particulate pollution rather than the greenhouse gases impact of global industrialization, fossil fuels burning and detonations of explosives increased the global warming of WWII era and continuing to increase it to date.</p> <p>Simply because the emissions of greenhouse gases and particulate aerosols would increase as global industrialization grows and/or global consumption of fossil fuels and explosives increase; and that, the author hasn't presented a comparison of the impacts of greenhouse gases and particulate aerosols including deliberately sprayed into the atmosphere coal fly ash , which shows that it is the particulate aerosols rather than greenhouse gases causing most of the increasing of the global warming of WWII, and causing most of its increasing to date.</p> <p>However, I would endorse this one for publication without hesitation because it is a useful call for the others who are also concerned to also think and research for what would enable to understand all main causes of the increasing of global warming and their shares of it most correctly.</p>
