Compulsory REVISION comments	The issue of biodegradable plastic production is very important. However, in that article only preliminary study was presented. The language should be corrected, some parts of manuscript are incomprehensible. The number of strains isolate was unrepresentative (50). The strains were identified only by biochemical tests (why not 16s rRNA method?). The author stated that strain which was able to PHB production probably belongs to <i>Bacillus</i> genera – it should be confirmed by genetic method. The discussion section is poor. The reference list should be standardized in accordance with the editorial requirements of the journal. Only a few quoted works were published during the last 5 years.	
Minor REVISION comments	The title of the work should be more specific - Isolation and Identification of bacteria strains able to biopolymer polyhydroxybutyrate (PHB) production from Soil of Al-Kharj probes, Saudi Arabia There is any statistic data. Whether the experiments were carried out in repetitions? There is: cultural conditions instead of culture conditions. In some sentence singular number is confused with plurals (lack of "s").	
Optional/General comments	In my opinion that article should not be published in that form.
