This needs to be in abstract also.</p> <p>As a standard format, Figure numbers and details are needed to be placed below the figures</p> <p>All the figures need to have legend</p> <p>Replace the text 'according to reference...' by 'as per the studies conducted on...'</p> <p>Break the first paragraph of conclusion into smaller sentences. At present it is one big sentence from line 319-325</p> <p>Re-modify the sentences as English is incorrect in them- line 326-327 ; 331-333 and many more places as indicated in the manuscript</p> <p>referencing style need to be same for all the references</p> <p>references missing in manuscript- 26</p>	
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	<p>Author/s need to add more references for grounding their literature review.</p>	



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	<p>In most of the cases the facts need to be supported with statistics – lines 47- 49, 57 - 59</p> <p>Add reference as indicated in the reviewed manuscript</p> <p>Few basic grammar errors may be removed if spell check and grammar check is run on the manuscript</p> <p>Line 156 sentence is incomplete at the specified mark</p> <p>Interpret figure 4. Secondly, how are the two figures indicating temporal variation in relation to climate and rainfall and temperature?</p>
