<p>The manuscript was properly revised and it shows improvement.</p> <p>There are some observations to be made, though:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the Abstract, the following sentence is not part of the goals of this study, but an introduction to the topic: "Toxoplasmosis is serious in the case of prenatal transmission. Congenital toxoplasmosis results in abortion or congenitally acquired disorders which primarily affect the central nervous system.</li> <li>2. Please, implement the discussion about more educated women with higher incidence of <i>T. gondii</i>. This is a very interesting part of your study and should be more developed and explained. For example, which Degrees these women hold? (If they were from Agricultural areas, they could have contacted soil...), how many of the women evaluated had cats?.. Try to find on literature if the same result was found in other studies and what the reason was for it. If there is no literature reporting this fact, highlight that few or no studies presented such results before ...</li> <li>3.</li> </ol>	<p>The sentence "Toxoplasmosis is serious in the case of prenatal transmission. Congenital toxoplasmosis results in abortion or congenitally acquired disorders which primarily affect the central nervous system" have been removed from the abstract.</p> <p>One plausible justification of the fact that more educated women had higher incidence of <i>T. gondii</i> have been given in the revised manuscript.
