Dear reviewer thank you for valuable comments and revision.  Unfortunately, we don't have any data related to effects of comorbid diseases on the outcome of the cataract surgery.  To emphasize the importance of the study following sentences were added to introduction section. "It has been shown that comorbid diseases have influence on the surgical success. For instance, it is reported that patients who have unregulated arterial blood hypertension and who use anticoagulants have higher risk of suprachoroidal haemorrhage and retinopathies of unregulated diabetic patients may worsen after the cataracts surgery."
