

### **Editor's Comment:**

My suggestion is minor revision before publication. Although the authors answered most of the reviewers' comments and did some revision, some parts still need to be revised before publication:

1). All the references are not correct without the "title of publication" information. The authors did not provide any 'title' information of the citation, which makes the readers unable to follow which citation exactly is referred. The authors should revise all references before publication. For example, in reference 8, there are only the author information, the publisher, year of publication and page number. Where is the title of the reference? How the readers know which paper is referred?

Please add more detailed information about each citation.
