<p>I think there might be misunderstandings between the author(s) and me. In my previous evaluation form, I gave some suggestions. I would like to describe them in more details at below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At the end of p.1, the sentence "Comparatively, few corresponding research has been done ..." should be "Comparatively, few corresponding researches have been done ..." 2. The figure number of the first picture of this revised manuscript has been changed as "Figure 1." However, the authors did not revise the other figure numbers. Therefore, there are two Figure 1s in this revised manuscript. Please correct them. 3. If possible, the authors are advised to give a note why the value of 'Re' in the second equation on p.3 is the mean radius of the Earth? Why not use the radius of the Earth around the equatorial region? <p>Since the above comments are rather unimportant. I think the editor can determine directly whether to accept this manuscript after the authors make revision.</p>	<p>There is no misunderstanding of any kind.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The sentence at the end of p. 1 effectively corrected. 2. The figures have been properly labelled, the error is an oversight. 3. Re as the mean radius of the Earth is generally accepted value.
